1.

*Say it with flowers.*

*Plant daffodil bulbs on waste ground on the approach to an airport runway, so that they spell 'I Love You'. Don't do this on an area that gets mowed. limited, so take care not to  
breathe too heavily.*

*Say it in the car.*

*Affix a note saying 'I Love You' to the sun visor. With your lover in the passenger seat, point the car towards the sun so they have to lower the visor and read your message. An alternative message might be, 'Would you like to borrow some sunglasses?'*

*Say it on an aeroplane.*

*Find out where the microphone
