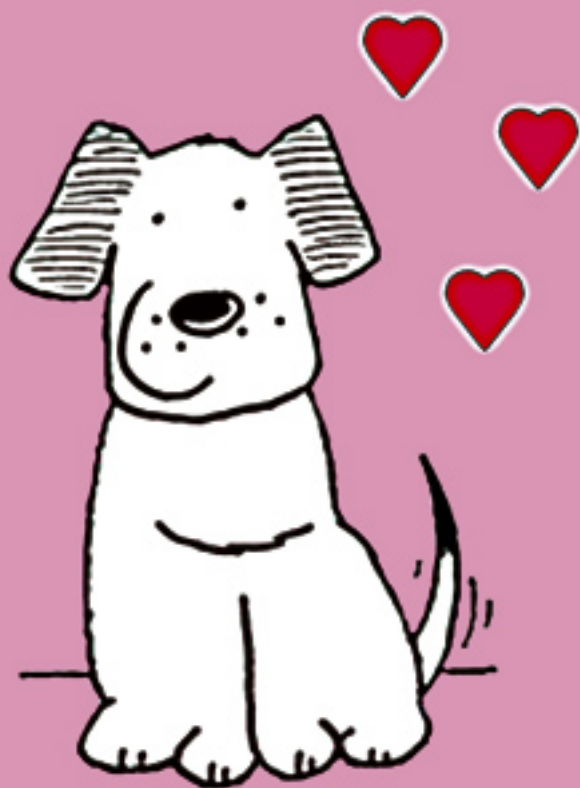


The more I see of men,
